

Our plans were to take a couple of weeks to rest and recover. Instead, we are spending the time at the heart institute at Cluj, 575 kms. from home with our little Rubie, for a second surgery to repair the hole in her heart. Among the many tests they also examined the cyst on her liver and we are so happy to report that it is shrinking and will not need to be surgically removed.

We also brought 16 year old Roxana along for her follow-up tests and praise the Lord, every thing looks real good. Another hospital had sent her home to die. but the doctors here performed a triple procedure operation and now she is doing just great.




Rubie and Roxana are both so happy to be alive and they have committed their live to the Lord Jesus since their operations.

Since our last report we have started serving up to 80 students a cereal **breakfast at two schools**. Children who would other wise have to study on an empty stomach are served hot Muesli. In Medgidia the main staple for the poor, is white bread; it fills the stomach but does not provide the body with important nutrients. Getting children and adults to switch to healthy cereal in it's self, is quite a challenge, however we see it as an important part of our overall objective. After a few days some of the children are asking for up to five servings.




Eurovangelism's Vision Trip team in front of a cave that The Apostle Andrew lived in while he ministered in what is now Constanta County.
