There is much work to be done to get all the paper work into place along with doctor check ups and making sure the child is parasite free. Lice and fleas are a major problem with the children who come from the poorer families.

There are children who do not have any identity and some camps will not receive children who do not have medical and birth records. The poor here face challenges that most westerners have never thought about. Getting parents permission along with all the other

preparations, like clean clothing, footwear, and toiletries, the task is quite a challenge. Once the children are in camp the work takes on a whole new facet with bible classes, sports, crafts, day trips, and the list goes on. Some children miss their parents and cry for hours before they fall asleep.

Some people have asked if it's worth all the hard work. If we do it with the attitude that we are doing it to Jesus, than it is worth it all and more. We see friendship made and hearts changed. Some children hear about Jesus and His love for the first time, and want to receive Him as their personal Savior. Some parents asked, "what have you done to our children in camp? They are so changed; they are behaving so well and are helpful around the home and are obedient."

The lives of some of these children are changed forever; they will never be the same. Like the Apostle Paul and so many others they had a meeting with JESUS.

Summer camp will stay in the hearts and memories of the children for the rest of their lives. Those who come from a very impoverished environment have experience a higher quality of life which encourages them to continue attending school and reach out for a better future.

At camp they have clean beds to sleep in, showers, three healthy meals a day, a sanitary and safe play area, people who lovingly care for them, as well as the good news that they are loved by God.

Again and again we thank you our generous, and loving supporters who are the backbone of our ministry efforts. Your donations are life changing and put a smile on the children's faces as well as on the face of our Dear Heavenly Father.
